If you have an outstanding loan with Western Region Federal Credit Union, you are entitled to skip a payment this holiday season (excluding real estate, credit card, advance pay and student loans).

If you have more than one loan with us, you'll skip a payment for each loan. The timing couldn't be better, and it couldn't be easier to do! Just select the month you want to skip – November, December or January – and we'll take care of the rest. If your payment is made through payroll deduction, it will be deposited into your credit union savings account until you need it.

There is a \$25 processing fee per loan to take advantage of this service. You don't have to send any money if you would like for us to simply deduct the fee from your credit union savings account. Otherwise, please make sure to get the fee amount into your savings account by the 12th of the month you choose to skip. Interest will continue to accumulate on your loan during the month you skip your payment.
